### In Brief

Purdue University Global's School of Health Sciences is committed to educating students to become skilled, compassionate professionals who are vital to the delivery of quality health care and helping others lead healthier lives. Whether a student's interest is in a clinical profession, such as medical assisting; health care administration/health informatics and information management; or public health/health education, the School of Health Sciences' career-focused programs are designed to prepare graduates to become tomorrow's health leaders, instilling critical-thinking skills to help them succeed in a constantly evolving health care environment.

### Health Sciences Programs

Purdue Global's School of Health Sciences offers 13 programs. These include bachelor's degree programs in health and wellness, health care administration, health information management, health science, and nutrition. The school also offers master's degree programs in health care administration, health informatics, health information management, public health, and health education. Additionally, the school offers three certificate programs in medical billing/coding, medical office administration, and medical assisting.

### Degrees Conferred

The School of Health Sciences conferred more than 3,600 degrees, certificates, and diplomas in the 2016–2017 academic year.
