* "Career Outcome Rate" is based on [NACE methodology](#) and includes graduates who are: (1) employed (whether full or part time); (2) participating in a program of voluntary service; (3) serving in the U.S. Armed Forces; or (4) enrolled in a program of continuing education. This rate may also include graduates who were employed while attending Purdue Global.

† Student satisfaction is based on surveys conducted at the end of the program. An average of 2.5 on a Likert Scale of 1-4 is considered a satisfactory rating. At the time of publication, the response rate to this survey was 66.6%.

‡ The graduation rate calculation is based on the group of 17 students who enrolled from July 1, 2013–June 30, 2014 and completed their program within 150% of the program's length. The reported graduation rate excludes 9 students who had to leave the program for personal reasons. Internal research has shown that personal and professional challenges unrelated to academics are the most common reasons why students do not complete their programs, and nearly 80% of students who cited those challenges were satisfied with their experience at Purdue Global.
