**Credit Hours:** 180

According to a 2022 report by the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration, in the previous year<sup>10</sup>:

- 48.7 million Americans aged 12 or older were classified with a substance use disorder
- 8.9 million people misused opioids
