

Kaplan University, Indianapolis - Graduation Rate

Cohort Period 09/01/10 to 08/31/11

A Graduation Rate calculation is based on a group of students who did not attend another college or university prior to attending Kaplan University. These students enrolled from September 1, 2010 - August 31, 2011 and completed their program within 150% of the program's length. In addition, certain students are excluded from the rate above in accordance with National Center for Education Statistics (NCES) guidelines. The graduation rates provided are calculated in accordance with Department of Education and NCES guidelines which consider only first time college students who attend Kaplan University full time. These rates may, therefore, not represent Kaplan University's overall population or graduation rate.

For example: A student enrolled in the 48 month Bachelor's Degree Program Graduated within 72 months.

The chart below reflects a breakdown of the percentage of students, students contained in the graduation rate calculation, by:

- Gender,
- Race/ethnicity,
- Federal grant recipients
- Subsidized federal loan recipients who did not receive federal grants
- Non-federal aid recipients (students who did not receive a subsidized federal loan ore federal grant)
