
# **GRADUATION EVENT GUIDE**

## **PARKING AND TRANSPORTATION**

- DAR Constitution Hall does not have parking available onsite. Therefore, those not comfortable walking 4 blocks should consider using a taxi service, Uber, or Lyft.
- Colonial Parking has several garages, with the closest being approximately 4 blocks from DAR. Visit <u>www.ecolonial.com</u> to view garages, rates, and reserve a spot. Metered street parking may be available around the DAR Constitution Hall, but availability will depend on local governmental events that day.
- Persons with disabilities should use the D Street entrance, which enters at lobby level of the DAR Constitution Hall. The ramp on D Street may be accessed by vehicles for dropping off patrons with mobility disabilities. There is no parking available onsite.
- Public Transportation (Metro)–For graduates and guests who are local to Washington, D.C., DAR Constitution Hall
  is accessible from the 18th Street NW and D Street NW Metrobus stop, as well as the Farragut West Metrorail Orange/Blue
  line stop, and the Farragut North Metrorail Red line stop. View bus/rail schedules and directions from your location:

## **THINGS TO REMEMBER**

- Bring your reader card to the ceremony (included in this packet).
- Pre-ordered regalia: Wear cap, gown, and tassel (Hint: Use bobby pins to hold cap in place).
- Bring your hood (master's and doctoral degrees only).
- Bring cash for purchases, including Purdue Global items from the Student Store.
- Do not bring personal items to the staging room as there is no place to store them.
- Graduates are required to stay in the Hall until degrees are conferred at the end of the ceremony.
- Graduates will be dismissed outside of the building after the ceremony. Guests should meet their graduate on D Street.
- Please notify guests that helium balloons and noise makers are not allowed in the venue.

## **EMPLOYMENT SEARCH ASSISTANCE**

### Career Services can help you to prepare for life after graduation.

The CareerNetwork is accessible via the Purdue Global Campus portal, and designed as a social platform for you to collaborate with other students, fellow graduates, and the Career Services team to answer specific job search questions. In addition, you can search for jobs 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. The job tracker has been created specifically for Purdue University Global students and focuses on positions based on a student's program of study and geographic location. The tracker houses job posts from CareerBuilder and its partners, thus offering a large number of available jobs for you to view.

The CareerNetwork also allows you to create a professional profile that offers the opportunity to:

- Complete a work interest assessment
- Submit a resume and cover letter for review/guidance
- Sign up for an exit interview with a Career Services staff member upon graduation
- Update current employment status
- Apply for employment opportunities geared toward your program of study and geographic area

## Attire

- Wear low heels or flats as there are stairs in the venue.
- All graduates participating in the ceremony must wear regalia: black gown, black cap, tassel.
- **Cap and tassel:** Graduates are allowed to decorate the tops of their caps if decorations are in good taste and appropriate for all audiences. All tassels are black and gold. Undergraduate-level candidates wear tassels on the RIGHT side of the cap. Master's-level and doctoral-level candidates wear tassels on the LEFT side of your cap.
- **Hood:** Master's-level and doctoral-level graduates will be hooded during the ceremony, so graduates should carry the hood folded over your arm (not wear it). The hood's velvet border is color-coded by program of study.
- Deadline for online regalia orders has passed. If you missed the deadline, call Jostens at 800-854-7464 to see if a late order can be filled. Late orders are not guaranteed and may be subject to additional late/rush fees.

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### **Reader Card**

Your reader card is included in this packet. Please bring your reader card to the ceremony as it is used to announce your name and degree when you cross the stage. Graduates receiving a bachelor's or associate's degree with a cumulative GPA of 3.70 or higher received an academic honor cord in this packet as well. Please review the information on your reader to ensure it is correct. Visit the Graduate Services Desk on Friday or Saturday for corrections. If you have a name that is difficult to announce, please spell it out as it sounds at the top of your reader card.

### Tickets

All graduates and guests over the age of 1 year old will require tickets for entry to commencement on Saturday, August 10, 2019. Each ticket has a unique code that will be scanned upon entry to the building. If copies are made, the first one scanned will gain entry, and all other copies will be denied. Digital tickets may be printed at home or shown at the door on your device. Tickets are not needed for Friday events.

### Seating

Guest seating is not assigned and on a first-come, first-served basis. Graduate seating is assigned and based on school and degree level. Doors will open one hour before the ceremony. ADA-accessible seating is available within the Hall for both graduates and guests. To ensure safety, infants and small children must be seated in the guest seating area and supervised by an adult guest during the ceremony.

#### **Disability Services**

The DAR Constitution Hall complies with ADA requirements. Designated ADA seating is located within the Hall. Guests do not require reservations for accessible seating, but should notify the ushers upon arrival. Graduates requiring accessible seating or assistance crossing the stage should contact the Center for Disability Services at cds@purdueglobal.edu by July 26, 2019, to make arrangements. Graduates and guests with mobility impairments are encouraged to bring their own wheelchairs to the graduation events.

#### Diplomas

Diplomas are not distributed at the graduation ceremony. Diplomas are automatically mailed by the Office of the Registrar approximately eight weeks after graduates complete their final class and fulfill all program and financial requirements as stated in the University Catalog. ## Photography

Lifetouch Photography will take professional individual headshot photos of graduates, in addition to capturing each graduate on stage. Graduates will be emailed the photography website link to view and purchase photographs 2–3 weeks after the ceremony. Graduates and guests may take photographs during the ceremony from their seats, but are prohibited from standing in the aisles.



#### **Flower Sales**

Volunteers from the Kiwanis Club of Hagerstown, Maryland, will sell fresh roses at commencement on Saturday. Roses can be purchased as a single stem for \$4 or half-dozen bouquets for \$15. **Cash only.** 100% of flower proceeds go to the Kiwanis Club foundation which supports youth activities, primarily for those less fortunate, including, but not limited to, The Boys and Girls Club and Girls Inc.
