Parking and Transportation

- Be patient with our parking attendants; they will be doing their best to assist you, but the parking lots fill up quickly. They will direct you and your guests as quickly as possible.
- Guests using wheelchairs may be dropped off and picked up at the front of the high school.

Things to Remember

- Check in at the gymnasium for the following items needed for the ceremony:
 - Commencement tickets (give to guests)
 - Reader cards (keep these with you)
 - Academic honor cords for associate's and bachelor's degrees for those with GPA above 3.7
- Pre-order regalia: Wear cap, gown, and tassel (Hint: Use bobby pins to hold cap in place).
- Bring your hood (master's and doctoral degrees only).
- Do not bring personal items to the staging room, as there is no place to store them.
- Graduates are required to stay in the auditorium until degrees are conferred at the end of the ceremony.

General Overview

Attire

- Dress: Business professional.
- Wear low heels or flats as there are many stairs in the venue.
- All students participating in the ceremony must wear regalia.
- Cap: Graduates are allowed to decorate the tops of their caps. Decorations must be in good taste, and appropriate for all audiences.
- Undergraduate-level candidates: Tassel is color-coded by program of study and should be placed on RIGHT side of cap.

DUE GL®BAL

- Master's-level and doctoral-level candidates: Tassel is black and should be placed on LEFT side of cap. Master's-level and doctoral-level graduates will be hooded during the ceremony, so graduates should carry the hood over your left arm (not wear it). The hood's velvet border is color-coded by program of study.
- Deadline for online regalia orders has passed. If you missed the deadline, call Jostens at 800-854-7464 to see if a late order can be filled. Late orders are not guaranteed and may be subject to additional late/rush fees.
- A list of degrees and corresponding tassel/hood colors can be found on the Graduation Center page.
- Honors regalia
 - Worn during the ceremony as part of the academic costume.
 - Associate's- and bachelor's-level graduates who complete their degrees with cumulative grade point averages (GPAs) of 3.70 or higher will achieve academic honors status. Certificate-, master's-, and doctor's-level graduates are not eligible for academic honors. Academic honors statuses will be noted on diplomas and transcripts. Academic honors statuses will be noted in the commencement program based on the student's GPA.
 - Honor Society Regalia: Honor society members of all degree levels can wear their regalia at the ceremony.

Seating

Seating is open and on a first-come, first-serve basis. Doors will open for guest seating one hour prior to each ceremony. ADA-accessible seating is available within the auditorium for both graduates and guests with prior notification to marylandgraduation@purdueglobal.edu. Graduate seating is reserved and based on school and degree level. To ensure safety, infants and small children must be seated in the guest seating area and supervised by an adult guest during the ceremony. Please be respectful of other graduates and guests and remain seated until the end of the ceremony.

Tickets

Guest tickets are required and can be picked up at graduate check-in. Children under 3 are not required to have a ticket, as they are expected to sit on the lap of an adult. Graduates do not need a ticket.



Diplomas

Diplomas are not distributed at the graduation ceremony. Diplomas are automatically mailed by the Office of the Registrar approximately eight weeks after graduates complete their final class and fulfill all program and financial requirements as stated in the University Catalog. Photography

Professional photographers from Lifetouch Photography will take individual headshot photos of the graduate and/ or group photos of graduates with families and friends 90 minutes before the ceremony, in addition to capturing each graduate on stage. Approximately 2–3 weeks after the ceremony, graduates will be emailed the photography website link to view photographs and order prints. Graduates and guests may take photographs during the ceremony from their seats, but are prohibited from standing in the aisles.



Flower Sales

During each ceremony, flowers will be available for purchase (cash only).

Graduation Day Information for Students

No Smoking: North Hagerstown High School is smoke-free. Smoking is not permitted anywhere on school property; this includes parking lots. Uniformed security will be patrolling the grounds and parking lots; if you, or anyone in your party, are found smoking, you will be asked to leave.

Arrive Early: All graduates must report to the graduate check-in area. Please advise your family to arrive at least 30 minutes before the scheduled ceremony as it will take a while to park, enter the building, and find a seat in the auditorium. Doors for seating in the auditorium for family and friends will open an hour before each ceremony. When graduates are entering the auditorium, guests arriving late will have to wait in the lobby for the procession to complete before entering the auditorium.

Graduate Check-In and Group Photos: Upon arrival, please go directly to the check-in tables in the gymnasium area. Look for individuals in red or black Purdue University Global polo shirts, who will direct you. Each graduate will check in and be directed to their appropriate lines for the processional. Group and family photos will be available 90 minutes before the ceremony. After family photos are taken in the gymnasium, guests should proceed to the auditorium for seating. We ask that only graduates enter the check-in/graduate gymnasium area due to space limitations. Graduates, please remain in this area until the ceremony procession begins. Graduates may leave their coats and purses in the locker rooms, but this is not a secure area. It is best to leave valuables with your family in the auditorium.

Helpful Hints

- Be Prepared to Walk—Before processing into the auditorium, you will line up in a holding area with your classmates. There is a moderate distance between the holding area and the auditorium, which does include stairs. If you or a family member needs any special accommodations, please email marylandgraduation@purdueglobal.edu.
- **Do Not Arrive Earlier Than Requested**—While we encourage you to arrive early enough to become familiar with the area, if you do not have questions or do not require assistance, please refrain from arriving too early to avoid long wait periods.
- Missing Items/Need to Exchange—After visiting the check-in, if you are missing or need to exchange any items, please let the check-in attendants know.
- **Graduation Ceremony Reader Cards**—At check-in, you will receive your graduation ceremony reader card, which contains your name and degree. Emphasis areas are not included, as these are not announced at the ceremony or listed in the graduation program. It is essential that you have your reader card with you at the ceremony.
